  - Articles may be removed only by Declarant in its sole discretion and without any need for meeting or vote. Declarant shall have the unqualified right to name a successor for any Director designated and thereafter removed by it or for any vacancy on the First Board as to a Director designated by it, and Declarant shall notify the First Board as to any such removal or vacancy and the name of the successor Director and of the commencement date for the term of such successor Director. Vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled by appointment by a majority vote of the remaining Directors for the remainder of the unexpired term; provided that when a Director has been recalled by the membership, the vacancy created by his removal cannot be filled with the same person as has been removed from the Board and provided further that the person appointed to fill the vacancy owns a parcel in the same Neighborhood as the departing Director that created the vacancy. A director may resign at any time by delivering a written notice to the Board of Directors or its chair or to the Corporation. A resignation is effective when the notice is delivered unless the notice specifies a later effective date.
